



WCT Adelboden International 10.09. – 13.09.2020

Competition Rules

- The WCT Adelboden International is open to 16 teams playing a triple knock-out.
- Each game is played over 8 ends. If the game is tied after 8 ends, an extra end will be played.
- If this end has no score, a Last Stone Draw (LSD) shootout after the extra end will decide the winner. That shot will also decide which team gets the hammer in the next game.
- The winners of the quarterfinals qualify for the semifinals; the other 4 teams are equally ranked in 5th place.
- The winners of the semifinal matches will play in the final for first and second place; the two other teams are equally ranked in the 3rd place.
- There is no time limit. However, we kindly ask teams to play in a timely manner.
- The tournament will be played according to the rules of the WCF.



Hammer

- The first named team starts with two practice stones in the pregame practice. The stones may be played towards the home end, followed by the LSD.
- In the following games the Last Stone Draw (LSD) will determine which team has the hammer in the next game.
- In the quarterfinals, the team from the higher road has the hammer.

Last Stone Draw (LSD)

- After each game, each team delivers one stone, with sweeping allowed, to the tee at the home end. The winning team will play first.
- All stones finishing in the house are measured. Stones that do not finish in the house are recorded as 185.4.

Time Outs

- Are not allowed.
